


How can I find my Tax Identification Number (TIN)?

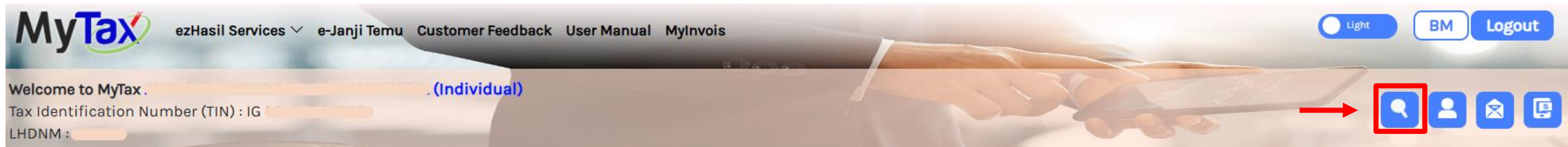
TIN Search e-Daftar ByrHASiL e-TT

Note:

- In Malaysia, both individuals and entities who are registered taxpayers with the Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (IRBM) are assigned with a Tax Identification Number (TIN)
- TIN will be issued to all Malaysian citizens who attained the age of 18 years old and above.

How can I find my Tax Identification Number (TIN)?

After successfully logging in, click on the “Search” icon:



Choose Individuals / Other Than Individuals & Category:

For Individuals:

The system only allows TIN searches for Identification Numbers and Passport Numbers. For Military and Police Numbers, taxpayers need to update their Identification Number via [Customer Feedback Form](#)
