


You may find your Tax Identification Number (TIN) by logging in MyTax Portal: https://mytax.hasil.gov.my/




Note:


- In Malaysia, both individuals and entities who are registered taxpayers with the Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (IRBM) are assigned with a Tax Identification Number (TIN)
- TIN will be issued to all Malaysian citizens who attained the age of 18 years old and above.



After successfully logging in, click on the "Search" icon:




